- Led One Acre Fund Tanzania, delivering life-changing inputs and extension services to nearly 200,000 smallholder farmers in 350+ remote rural villages.
- Managed a team of 550 employees and achieved a total turnover of ~\$25m, demonstrating consistent growth since joining the organization in 2015.
- Improved program performance annually despite challenges such as a global pandemic, adverse climate conditions, and rising fertilizer prices. Key achievements include:
  - Repayment rates increased from 90% in 2018 to 99% in 2022.
  - Average farmers served per village rose from 160 in 2018 to >190 in 2022.
  - Reduced total net deficit from \$8.4m in 2019 to ~\$6m in 2022.
  - Farmers consistently achieved ~30% higher yields compared to control.
  - Improved hunger, food security, and farmer's asset base indicators compared to control.
- Pioneered the transition to a fully digital platform for repayment, enrollment, and client orders.
- Established a network of ~40 retail shops in rural locations across 4 regions.
- Diversified investments (despite lowering overall net deficit) to include an Agroforestry department, delivering 2.5 million trees to farmers over two seasons and introducing a Carbon Credit trial.
- Received the highest team satisfaction rating among 9 One Acre Fund countries in the 2021 Team Culture Survey, with 97% of staff feeling positive about their work and the organization.
